Dear Ms. Bose:

This is to advise the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission" or "FERC") that Palomar Gas Transmission, LLC (Palomar) is reviewing its project plan to reflect potential changes in its commercial arrangements. Palomar continues to seek additional commercial underpinning for the project. Additionally, NorthernStar Pipeline Company, LLC, which is a major shipper on the Palomar pipeline, and certain of its affiliates have recently made Chapter 7 bankruptcy filings.

Later this year, depending on the results of commercial discussions and the outcome of the bankruptcy proceeding, Palomar may amend its application to reflect such changes. In the meantime Palomar is continuing with certain environmental field surveys in anticipation that the FERC Staff's National Environmental Policy Act review would resume upon submittal by Palomar of supplemental information regarding such changes, including any necessary amendment to Palomar's application.

Palomar is e-filing this information in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet* guidelines, issued in Docket No. RM07-16-000 on November 15, 2007.
